# School-Wide Title I Participation Defined

A Title I Schoolwide program is a method of delivering Title I services in eligible schools. It allows the school to address the educational needs of children living in impoverished communities with comprehensive strategies for improving the entire school so every student achieves high levels of academic proficiency.

# Academic assessments to monitor progress

- Our universal screener for both literacy and math is AIMSweb
- Universal assessments are administered to ALL K-5 students in fall, winter and spring
- Data is analyzed by all classroom teachers and specialists to determine if any students are in need of additional supports from Title I or EL

# Monitoring Progress

- Students with identified skill deficiencies are monitored weekly to ensure they are effectively responding to intervention supports.
- Students not responding to intervention supports provided may be referred to our Response to Intervention Team for additional problem solving



# Parent Notification

- Families are notified via a signed letter from our Title I staff and Principal indicating if a child will receive supplemental support in the area(s) of reading or math based on consistent analysis of achievement data.
