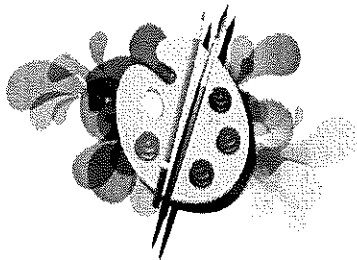

Grant School General Guidelines for KOTG:

- *Parents are always welcome to attend any class.
- *Enrollment may be limited. Class assignments may be based on a lottery system.
