

Target Area for Improvement: Social/Emotional Growth

Improvement Goal:

Expand social skills of all students to foster a positive sense of community, and to develop strong citizens.

Expectations for student learning:

Demonstrated willingness to work through difficulties with others

Demonstrated pride in achievement and behavior

Reduce *major* office disciplinary referrals directly related to defiance/disrespect by 8%: From 28% to 20% by May of 2018 as measured by BTFs entered in out SWIS database.

Targeted participants:

All students

Interventions:

Positive Behavior Intervention Supports (PBIS)

Re-teach behaviors using individual classroom matrices when behavior issues arise

CICO (Check-In/Check-Out)

Bi-Weekly Tier II & Tier III PBIS Meetings

Tier III wrap around supports as needed

School-Wide Boosters and Community Assemblies focused on Core Values and Positive Character Traits

Monthly paired grade level activities focused on responsibility, respect, and safety

School-Wide family engagement activities to promote/support social/emotional growth

Zones of Regulation strategies for identified groups of students

Evaluation:

- Decreased major office referrals as stated on Office Discipline Referral forms (BTF)
- Maintain number of Bulldog Bucks earned by students at 100,000
